Especially social aspects and improvements were highlighted but also difficulties and future plannings. The visited

projects included the following sites: Enschede – Roombeek, Amsterdam – Bijlmermeer, Rivierenwijk – Deventer, Voorstad Oost – Deventer.

All project partners had the occasion to get in contact and discuss with planners, local experts and inhabitants, to see acitivities and ongoing projects and to collect impressions of the daily life in the visited sits.

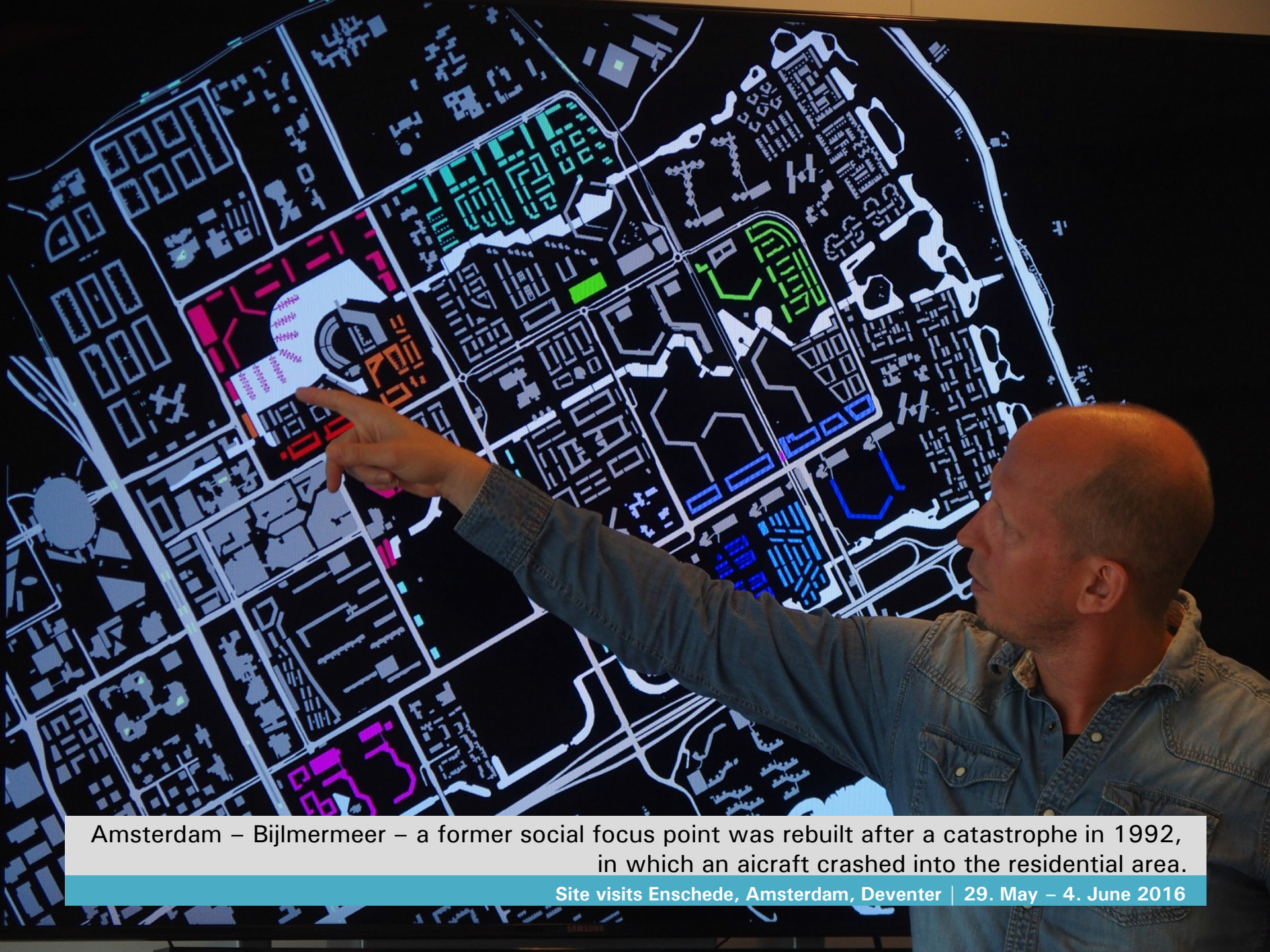
