

#### **TERMINOLOGY**

#### **Intentional Community**

An **intentional community** is a planned <u>residential community</u> designed from the start to have a high degree of <u>social cohesion</u> and <u>teamwork</u>. The members of an intentional community typically hold a common <u>social</u>, <u>political</u>, <u>religious</u>, or <u>spiritual</u> vision and often follow an <u>alternative lifestyle</u>. They typically share responsibilities and resources. Intentional communities include <u>collective</u> households, <u>cohousing</u> communities, <u>ecovillages</u>, <u>communes</u>, <u>survivalist retreats</u>, <u>kibbutzim</u>, <u>ashrams</u>, and <u>housing</u> <u>cooperatives</u>. New members of an intentional community are generally selected by the community's existing membership, rather than by real-estate agents or land owners (if the land is not owned collectively by the community).


#### Co-Housing

A **cohousing**<sup>[1]</sup> community is a type of <u>intentional community</u> composed of private <u>homes</u> supplemented by shared facilities. The community is planned, owned and managed by the residents – who also share activities which may include cooking, dining, child care, gardening, and governance of the community. Cohousing facilitates interaction among neighbors for social and practical benefits, economic and environmental benefits.<sup>[2][3]</sup>

#### Ecovillage *Öko-Dorf*



On the edge of the Dunkelsteiner Forest


















SIZE OF THE PROJECT: 29 units;

built in 2 phases, Dec 2013 people moved in)

SIZE OF THE UNITS: 50 to 122 m2

WAY OF BUILDING: Prefab/ timber frame construction, partly low-

energy houses, other passive house standard

MEMBERS: 51 adults and 28 children/youth

COSTS PER UNIT: share of equity ca. 300 €/m2; Rent 9 € / m²; optional purchase after 10 years; Includes the cost of the 500 m² communal space!



- FACILITATION OF MEETINGS






## SHARING FOOD & COOKING

- > TIME SAVING AND IMPORTANT SPACE FOR SOCIAL INTERACTION







#### LIFE STYLE WITH REDUCED USE OF RESSOURCES

- Compact flat floor plans
- Exchange of time, skills and ressources
- REUSE & UPCYCLING of furniture etc.
- Reduced use of cleaning supplies
- Cloth-swopping, ,no cost shop'







## **SHARES SPACES**

COLLECTIVELY USED, CLEANED, PAID FOR, DECORATED....

600 m2 with professional kitchen, 2 spacious multifunctional rooms, wintergarden, childrens room, laundry, quiet room, sauna, food coop, crafts room





#### **COMMUNITY GARDEN**

**OUTDOOR SPACE**: 10.000m<sup>2</sup> in development

- Important for relaxation, contact with nature and also for celebrations
- Thriving and struggling with the aim > self sufficiency
- Permaculture strategy of an edible landscape
- Additional fruit garden close by is leased
- Shared terrasses, play areas, swimming pond,...
- All units have a small private garden or a balcony







#### COLLECTIVE - PRIVATE

#### **EVERYONE HAS HIS/HER OWN**

- KITCHEN AND BATHROOM
- SMALL GREEN AREA (GARDEN OR BALCONY)
- THERE ARE NO FENCES, BUT RULES TO PROTECT PRIVACY
- SOME ISSUES WITH CATS (TOO MANY!)





## **Eco-TECHNOLOGY**

- low-energy houses in rows
- Solar energy for hot water
- wood pellets heating system
- rainwater collection for use in the garden
- everyone on green-electricity
- no/less Wlan







#### **MOBILITY**

- Schoolbus stop right in front of main entrance
- alternative is a 25 min walk to the schools, 1 h to the train station
- Initiative for a communal bus service
- Biking (20 min to train station, 1 h to St.Pölten)
- E-BIKEs (E-service station in planned)
- CAR SHARING: 6 cars, 1 Volkswagen Bus shared in the group, potentially expansion to the neighborhood
- Shared rides, whatsup group for coordination









## REGIONAL FOOD SUPPLIES

- FOOD COOP (shared bulk purchase)
   veggies, dry food, dairy, cleaning supplies
- CSA (community supported agriculture/ farm in the region)
- "iron rations"
- Reduction of mobility for groceries
- Organic is more affordable
- Some produce from the village (potatoes, eggs, applejuice...)

## LOCAL ECONOMY

- Ca. 1/3 Independent (individual entrepreneur, NGOs,..)
  - 1/3 Employees (St.Pölten, Krems, Wien,..)
  - 1/3 Maternity leave, retired etc.
- purchasing power for the region
- Know-How for the region (Pharmacist, Chemists, Coach, Teacher, Gardener, Designer, Musician, IT, Physiotherapist, social worker, alternative Educator, corporate consultant, etc.)







## **NEIGHBORHOOD**

- Seasonal celebrations (easter, christmas,..)
- Open day
- Personal contact
- informal interaction i.e. in the garden, local events
