

Severe Housing Deprivation – ANSWERS

Here you can find the answers to the assignment on EU-SILC to check after you have completed the assignment:

- a) From 5.7 to 3.8 % (2019 is an estimation)
- b) [Depends on the country]
- c) Highest Romania (14.2%); Lowest Finland (0.9%)
- d) Denmark, Ireland, The Netherlands and Sweden. These are countries with low housing deprivation rates. (The declining rate in the EU as a whole is mainly driven by the trend in Eastern Europe where severe housing deprivations tended to be much higher in 2010 compared to the rest of the EU).
- e) Severe deprivation rate is 5.8 % for persons below 18 years as against 3.8 % in the EU as a whole. That means that the risk is 53% higher for children than for the general population.
