PRECARIOUS HOUSING IN EUROPE WITH A FOCUS ON INTERNATIONAL MIGRANTS

July 4-8, 2022

The lack of decent, affordable housing and the occurrence of informal, illegal, or unsafe housing across all EU Member States poses a threat to social inclusion in the EU and hinders the mobility of EU citizens and the integration of third-country nationals. On this basis, we are developing learning materials on this topic within the Push partnership.

During our summer school, we combine these learning materials with hands-on activities, including meetings with policy-makers and practitioners, interactive workshops and more. While we will be in Venice most of the time, we plan a field trip to Parma where we will visit specific housing projects and discuss with local stakeholders there.
